22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-48-101(4), concerning the definition of
23	"intellectual and developmental disability", is amended to read as follows:
24	(4) "Intellectual and developmental disability" means a chronic
25	disability of a person an individual that:
26	(A)(i) Is attributable to an impairment of general
27	intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior, including cerebral palsy,
28	spina bifida, Down syndrome, epilepsy, or autism;
29	(ii) Is attributable to any other condition of a
30	person found to be closely related to intellectual and developmental
31	disability because the condition results in an impairment of general
32	intellectual functioning or adaptive behavior similar to that of a person
33	with an intellectual and developmental disability or requires treatment and
34	services similar to that required for a person with an intellectual and
35	developmental disability; or
36	(iii) Is attributable to dyslexia resulting from a
