## Subtitle

15 TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING A VACANCY ON  
16 A COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-4-102(f), concerning the election of  
22 members of the county boards of election commissioners, is amended to read as  
23 follows:

24 (f)(1)~~(A)~~ A vacancy on the county board of election commissioners  
25 shall be filled by ~~the election of a new member by the county committee of~~  
26 ~~the appropriate party~~ an appointment by the county chair of the appropriate  
27 party until an election is held by the county committee to elect a new member  
28 to fill the remainder of the term.

29 (B) If the county committee of the appropriate party does  
30 not have a county chair, the appointment under subdivision (f)(1)(A) of this  
31 section shall be made by the state chair of the appropriate party.

32 (2)(A) The county committee shall elect a new member within  
33 forty-five (45) days of a vacancy.

34 (B) If the county committee fails to elect a new member  
35 within forty-five (45) days of a vacancy, the state chair of the appropriate  
36 party shall appoint a new member to the county board of election



1 commissioners.

2 (C) The state chair of the appropriate party may appoint  
3 the same person under subdivision (f)(1) of this section and subdivision  
4 (f)(2)(B) of this section.
