6	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 18, Chapter 11, Subchapter 1, is		
7	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
8	18-11-110. Restrictions on regulation of short-term rentals and		
9	vacation rentals - Definitions.		
10	(a) As used in this section:		
11	(1) "Local government" means a city or county;		
12	(2)(A) "Short-term rental" means an individually or collectively		
13	owned single-family house or dwelling unit or a unit or group of units in a		
14	condominium, cooperative or timeshare, or owner-occupied residential home		
15	that is offered for a fee and for thirty (30) days or less.		
16	(B) "Short-term rental" does not include a unit that is		
17	used:		
18	(i) For retail;		
19	(ii) As a restaurant;		
20	(iii) As banquet space;		
21	(iv) As an event center; or		
22	(v) For any other similar use; and		
23	(3) "Short-term rental marketplace" means a person who provides		
24	a platform through which a lodging operator, or the authorized agent of the		
25	lodging operator, offers a short-term rental to an occupant.		
26	(b) A local government shall not enact or enforce an ordinance,		
27	resolution, rule, or other requirement of any type that prohibits or limits		
28	the use of a property as a short-term rental unit.		
29	(c) A short-term rental:		
30	(1) Shall be classified as residential land use for zoning		
31	purposes; and		
32	(2) Is subject to all zoning requirements applicable to property		
33	classified as residential land use for zoning purposes.		
34	(d) A local government shall not regulate the operation of a short-		
35	term rental marketplace.
