 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
- 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 19 the Department of Human Services - Division of Medical Services are, due to 20 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Human Services -Division of Medical Services to continue to provide essential governmental 21 22 services; that the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies 23 for the Department of Human Services - Division of Medical Services to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act 24 25 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared 26 27 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and 28 after the date of its passage and approval. 29
 - If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.

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
