8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL  
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF  
10 AGRICULTURE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

13 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE  
14 REAPPROPRIATION.  
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is  
21 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Agriculture, to be payable from the  
22 Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Agriculture the  
23 following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
25 in Item (H) of Section 1 of Act 87 of 2022, for various maintenance,  
26 renovation, equipping, professional services contracts for air tankers,  
27 construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of real property  
28 and facilities, personal services and operational expenses related to  
29 agricultural disasters, in a sum not to exceed .....\$14,926.

30 (B) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
31 in Item (I) of Section 1 of Act 87 of 2022, for various maintenance,  
32 renovation, equipping, professional services contracts for air tankers,  
33 construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and repair of real property  
34 and facilities, in a sum not to exceed .....\$22,210.  
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36 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - NECROPSY ROOM IMPROVEMENTS. There is



1 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Agriculture, to be payable from the  
2 Livestock and Poultry Special Revenue Fund, for the Department of Agriculture  
3 the following:

4 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
5 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 87 of 2022, for construction, renovation and  
6 equipping of the Necropsy Room at the Livestock and Poultry Diagnostic Lab,  
7 in a sum not to exceed .....\$69,563.

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9 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - BOND PROCEEDS. There is hereby  
10 appropriated, to the Department of Agriculture, to be payable from the Bond  
11 Proceeds, for the Department of Agriculture the following:

12 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
13 in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 87 of 2022, for construction of New Office  
14 Space, Laboratories and Support Facilities for the Department of Agriculture,  
15 in a sum not to exceed .....\$60,000,000.

16 (B) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
17 in Item (B) of Section 3 of Act 87 of 2022, for construction, renovation,  
18 repairs and equipping of new office space, laboratories, and support  
19 facilities for the Department of Agriculture, in a sum not to exceed  
20 .....\$60,000,000.

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22 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - NCRC GRANT. There is hereby appropriated,  
23 to the Department of Agriculture, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and  
24 Cultural Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Department of Agriculture  
25 the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2023, the balance of the appropriation provided  
27 in Section 24 of Act 196 of 2022, for acquisition, management, stewardship or  
28 preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings, structures or  
29 objects, in a sum not to exceed .....\$2,000,000.

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31 SECTION 5. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor  
32 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects  
33 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available  
34 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and  
35 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and  
36 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or

1 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State  
2 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects  
3 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds  
4 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General  
5 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall  
6 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

7 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State  
8 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the  
9 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of  
10 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
11 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
12 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided  
13 otherwise by law.

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15 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
16 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
17 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
18 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
19 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
20 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
21 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
22 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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24 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
26 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of  
28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
29 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
30 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm  
31 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
32 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
33 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
34 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
