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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
25 established for the Department of Finance and Administration - Assessment
26 Coordination Division for the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the following maximum
27 number of regular employees.

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9 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized,
 10 for the Department of Finance and Administration - Assessment Coordination
 11 Division for the 2023-2024 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-
 12 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds
 13 appropriated herein for such purposes: three (3) temporary or part-time
 14 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 15 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 16 for the appropriate classification.

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18 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 19 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration, to be payable
 20 from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and
 21 operating expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration -
 22 Assessment Coordination Division - State Operations for the fiscal year
 23 ending June 30, 2024, the following:

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3 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - REAL PROPERTY REAPPRAISAL. There is hereby
4 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration, to be payable
5 from the Arkansas Real Property Reappraisal Fund, for paying counties and
6 professional reappraisal companies for the cost of reappraisal of real
7 property by the Department of Finance and Administration - Assessment
8 Coordination Division - Real Property Reappraisal for the fiscal year ending
9 June 30, 2024, the following:

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15 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
17 FUND TRANSFER. To provide funding for the appropriations authorized herein,
18 the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration - Assessment
19 Coordination Division of the State of Arkansas shall certify monthly to the
20 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount of funding needed each month to
21 pay counties and professional reappraisal companies for the reappraisal of
22 real property as required by law. Upon receipt of such certification the
23 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and
24 those of the State Treasurer 76% of the amounts certified from the Department
25 of Education Public School Fund Account, 16% of the amount certified from the
26 County Aid Fund, and 8% of the amount certified from the Municipal Aid Fund
27 to the Arkansas Real Property Reappraisal Fund. In no event shall the total
28 amount of funds transferred as authorized herein exceed fourteen million two
29 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$14,250,000) in a single fiscal year.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2022~~
31 2023 through June 30, ~~2023~~ 2024.

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33 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 26-26-
34 1306 is amended to codify special language in appropriation acts to read as
35 follows:
36 26-26-1306. Liability for expenses.

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

2 ASSESSMENT OF VEHICLES. (a) For purposes of assessing the value of a used
3 vehicle:

4 (1) If a used vehicle was assessed in calendar year 2020 and is
5 assessed in calendar year 2022, the value of the used vehicle as assessed in
6 calendar year 2022 shall not be higher than its published assessed value in
7 calendar year 2020; and

8 (2) If under subdivision (a)(1), a used vehicle’s 2022 assessed
9 value is decreased, then a county assessor is not required to notify the
10 taxpayer of the decrease in the assessed value.

11 (b) Subsection (a) of this section shall be in effect only from the
12 effective date of this section through December 31, 2023.

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14 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
15 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
16 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
17 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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24 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
26 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
27 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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33 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
34 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
35 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
36 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
3 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
4 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
5 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
6 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
7 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.

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
