## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO AMEND THE RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT OF  
9 CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AFTER LEAVING OFFICE; TO  
10 RESTRICT A CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICER FROM CERTAIN TYPES  
11 OF EMPLOYMENT FOR TWO YEARS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.  
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### Subtitle

15 TO AMEND THE RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT  
16 OF CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS AFTER LEAVING  
17 OFFICE; AND TO RESTRICT A CONSTITUTIONAL  
18 OFFICER FROM CERTAIN TYPES OF EMPLOYMENT  
19 FOR TWO YEARS.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-1-402(f)(1), concerning restrictions on  
25 other employment, is amended to read as follows:

26 (f)(1) A former member of the General Assembly shall not take the  
27 following actions until two (2) years after the expiration of the term of  
28 office for which he or she was elected:

29 (A) Register as a lobbyist under § 21-8-601 et seq.; ~~or~~

30 (B) Enter into employment as the director of an:

31 (i) Educational cooperative under The Public School  
32 Educational Cooperative Act of 1981, § 6-13-901 et seq.; or

33 (ii) Area agency on aging; or

34 (C)(i) Enter into employment as a consultant or director  
35 with a firm, business, association, or other private entity with the primary  
36 purpose of lobbying an elected official of Arkansas.



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(ii) Subdivision (f)(1)(C)(i) of this section does

not apply to:

(a) The lobbying of an elected federal official or an elected official of another state; or

(b) Other lobbying activities at the national level.
