2	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS TECH UNIVERSITY. There is hereby
3	appropriated, to the Arkansas Tech University, to be payable from the
4	Development and Enhancement Fund, the following:
5	(A) for renovation for Brown building academic utilization, in a sum
6	not to exceed\$1,475,548.
7	(B) for utility upgrades, in a sum not to exceed\$4,524,452.
8	(C) for technology upgrades, in a sum not to exceed\$3,000,000.
9	(D) for critical maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$1,230,000.
10	(E) for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$3,860,000.
11	(F) for the purchase, replacement, and renewal of equipment and library
12	holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$1,157,352.
13	(G) for reroofing the Allied Health Building on the Ozark Campus, in a
14	sum not to exceed\$177,765.
15	(H) for costs of construction of the ATCC Tech Center, in a sum not to
16	exceed\$1,000,000.
17	(I) for costs of construction of the Ozark Technology and Trade Center,
18	in a sum not to exceed\$822,235.

35	hereby appropriated, to the Southern Arkansas University, to be payable from
36	the Davelonment and Enhancement Fund the following:

2	(B) for technology upgrades, in a sum not to exceed\$4,000,000.

9	There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas for Medical
10	Sciences, to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, the
11	following:
12	(A) for renovation of the Barton Building, in a sum not to exceed
13	\$2,000,000
14	(B) for renovation of the Monroe Building, in a sum not to exceed
15	\$2,000,000
16	(C) for renovation of the EDII 6th Floor for the College of Pharmacy,
17	in a sum not to exceed\$2,000,000.
18	(D) for renovation of the Central Building - Floors 2-8, in a sum not
19	to exceed\$2,000,000.
20	(E) for Central Building Clinical Lab AHU replacement, in a sum not to
21	exceed\$600,000.
22	(F) for Central Building Penthouse electrical infrastructure, in a sum
23	not to exceed\$450,000.
24	(G) for UAMS West Central Energy Plant Addition and Interconnect, in a
25	sum not to exceed\$950,000.
26	(H) for critical maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$7,220,000.
27	(I) for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$11,630,000.

31	SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS. There is hereby
32	appropriated, to the University of Arkansas, to be payable from the
33	Development and Enhancement Fund, the following:
34	(A) for restoration of the Agriculture Building, in a sum not to exceed
35	\$2,000,000
36	(B) for restoration of the Leflar Law Center North Wing, in a sum not

2	(C) for restoration of Memorial Hall, in a sum not to exceed

4	(D) for restoration and renovation of the Fine Arts Center and

3	(U) for renovation of the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences,
4	and the Arts (ASMSA) maintenance shop, in a sum not to exceed\$900,000.
5	(V) for ASMSA campus ADA accessibility improvements, in a sum not to
6	exceed\$250,000.
7	(W) for STEM Research Lab upgrades, in a sum not to exceed\$350,000.

9	SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT FORT SMITH. There
10	is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Fort Smith, to be
11	payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, the following:
12	(A) for costs of construction and renovation for the UAFS Center for
13	Workforce Development, in a sum not to exceed\$6,522,500.
14	(B) for critical maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$570,000.
15	(C) for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$1,670,000.
16	(D) for the purchase, replacement, and renewal of equipment and library
17	holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$622,683.
18	
19	SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT LITTLE ROCK.
20	There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Little Rock,
21	to be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, the following:
22	(A) for improvements to technology infrastructure, in a sum not to
23	exceed\$3,500,000.
24	(B) for building infrastructure and critical maintenance, in a sum not
25	to exceed\$3,000,000.
26	(C) for classroom technology improvements, in a sum not to exceed
27	\$3,000,000.
28	(D) for critical maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$6,590,000.
29	(E) for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$5,680,000.
30	(F) for the purchase, replacement, and renewal of equipment and library
31	holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$1,542,601.
32	
33	SECTION 9. APPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT MONTICELLO. There
34	is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Monticello, to be
35	payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, the following:
36	(A) for renovation of the Math and Science Center, in a sum not to

1	exceed\$3,250,000.
2	(B) for HVAC upgrades for MCB and Science Center, in a sum not to
3	exceed\$2,500,000.
4	(C) for renovation of the Fine Arts Center, in a sum not to exceed
5	\$1,000,000.
6	(D) for renovation of the Music Building, in a sum not to exceed
7	\$750,000.
8	(E) for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$2,430,000.
9	(F) for the purchase, replacement, and renewal of equipment and library
10	holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$408,269.
11	(G) for costs of construction of the Workforce/Collegiate Center on the
12	Crossett campus, in a sum not to exceed\$2,000,000.
13	(H) for deferred maintenance for the Crossett campus, in a sum not to
14	exceed\$120,000.
15	(I) for costs of construction of a General Education Building on the
16	McGehee campus, in a sum not to exceed\$2,000,000.
17	(J) for deferred maintenance for the McGehee campus, in a sum not to
18	exceed\$150,000.
19	
20	SECTION 10. APPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT PINE BLUFF.
21	There is hereby appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, to
22	be payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, the following:
23	(A) for renovation for fire protection, in a sum not to exceed
24	\$2,000,000.
25	(B) for renovation of dormitory, in a sum not to exceed\$2,000,000.
26	(C) for renovation of the police station, in a sum not to exceed
27	\$1,000,000.
28	(D) for campus security fencing, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.
29	(E) for renovation of restrooms, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.
30	(F) for domestic water upgrades, in a sum not to exceed\$500,000.
31	(G) for elevator upgrades and modernization, in a sum not to exceed
32	\$500,000.
33	(H) for critical maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$490,000.
34	(I) for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$1,630,000.
35	(J) for the purchase, replacement, and renewal of equipment and library
36	holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$373,244.

2	SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION - UNIVERSITY OF CENTRAL ARKANSAS. There is
3	hereby appropriated, to the University of Central Arkansas, to be payable
4	from the Development and Enhancement Fund, the following:
5	(A) for renovation/replacement of the Lewis Science Center, in a sum
6	not to exceed\$3,000,000
7	(B) for renovation of Mashburn Hall, in a sum not to exceed
8	\$3,000,000
9	(C) for renovation of Old Main, in a sum not to exceed\$3,000,000
10	(D) for critical maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$1,080,000
11	(E) for deferred maintenance, in a sum not to exceed\$3,890,000
12	(F) for the purchase, replacement, and renewal of equipment and library
13	holdings, in a sum not to exceed\$1,977,174.
14	
15	SECTION 12. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
16	obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
17	described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
18	therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
19	agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
20	donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
21	funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
22	Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
23	enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
24	otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
25	Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
26	not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.
27	(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
28	Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
29	Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of
30	this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
31	Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
32	disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
33	otherwise by law.
34	
35	SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
2	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
7	
8	SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
9	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
10	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
11	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
14	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
15	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
16	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
17	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
18	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
