1 2 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GEOSTOR AND FRAMEWORK. There is hereby 3 appropriated, to the Department of Transformation and Shared Services -4 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be payable from the 5 Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the duties, 6 responsibilities, and authority of the Arkansas State Land Information Board 7 as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create, operate, and maintain 8 Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure; and to create, update, 9 maintain, and disseminate framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the following: 10 11 12 ITEM FISCAL YEAR 13 NO. 2023-2024 (01) GEOSTOR & FRAMEWORK 14 \$1,200,000 15 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 18 OF CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds remaining on June 30 of 19 each fiscal year in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the Arkansas 20 Geographic Information Office, shall be transferred to the Geographic 21 Information Systems Fund to be used for operating and maintaining the 22 Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure, creating, updating, maintaining and 23 disseminating framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code §15-21-502. (1) Prior to June 30, 2023 2024 the Agency shall by written statement set 24 25 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the 26 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 27 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 28 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the 29 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting 30 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or 31 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name 32 or line item, the funding source of the appropriation and a copy of the 33 written request set forth in (1) above; 34 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 35 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee

containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written

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- 1 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose, etc.
- 2 for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty
- 3 (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
- 4 presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
- 5 Budget Committee; and
- 6 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 7 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
- 8 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 9 Institution.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2022 2023 through June 30, 2023 2024.

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SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 13 14 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 16 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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35 36 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

1	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
2	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
3	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
4	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
5	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
6	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
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
