25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-5-104(d), concerning the allocation of
28 election expenses, is amended to read as follows:

29 (d) No ~~county board of election commissioners~~ state or county employee
30 or official shall take or accept any funding, grants, or gifts for the
31 purpose of paying election related expenses from any source other than from:

- 32 (1) A city or incorporated town;
- 33 (2) The governing authority of the county;
- 34 (3) The State of Arkansas; or
- 35 (4) The United States Government.
