- 21 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
- 22 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the current membership makeup
- 23 of the Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board contains an unconstitutional
- 24 <u>racial requirement that requires the Governor to meet a racial quota when</u>
- 25 <u>appointing members to the Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board when similarly</u>
- 26 qualified Arkansas citizens would not be considered to fulfill any open
- 27 positions until the racial requirement has been met; that the practice of
- 28 social work affects the public health, safety, and welfare, and the Arkansas
- 29 <u>Social Work Licensing Board is tasked with ensuring the public health,</u>
- 30 <u>safety</u>, and welfare through the regulation of the practice of social work;
- 31 and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure that the open membership
- 32 positions of the Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board be filled by a
- 33 qualified citizen of this state, regardless of race. Therefore, an emergency
- 34 is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the
- 35 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
- 36 <u>on:</u>
