35	utilizes vote centers, the vote centers for the runoff election shall be the	
36	vote centers that are located within a precinct composed of qualified	

1	electors who are eligible to vote in that runoff election.
2	(iii) When a runoff election is required in a county
3	that only utilizes vote centers and where no vote center is located in one or
4	more precincts composed of qualified electors participating in the runoff
5	election, the county board of election commissioners shall:
6	(a) Establish one (1) or more vote centers
7	within the jurisdiction for which the runoff election is being conducted
8	prior to the publication of the notice of election; or
9	(b) Open a vote center at the county seat if
10	no polling site is otherwise available on election day under this section.
11	(B)(i) The county board of election commissioners shall
12	not change a vote center location for any precinct less than thirty (30)
13	sixty (60) days before an a preferential primary election or general
14	election, except in the event of an emergency.
15	(ii) The county board of election commissioners
16	shall not change a vote center location less than thirty (30) days before an
17	election other than for a preferential primary of general election, except in
18	the event of an emergency.
19	(iii) The county board of election commissioners may
20	establish a new vote center for an election less than thirty (30) days before
21	an election if the county board of election commissioners determines the
22	existing vote centers do not adequately serve the county's qualified
23	electors.
24	(iv) A vote center established under subdivision
25	(e)(2)(B)(iii) of this section shall be included in the notice of election.
