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1 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-14-703 and 20-14-704 are amended to read 2 as follows: 20-14-703. Central registry - Reports. 3 4 (a) The Brain Injury Alliance of Arkansas is a nonprofit organization 5 devoted entirely to persons who have suffered head injuries. It is an 6 affiliate of the United States Brain Injury Alliance. The alliance shall 7 establish and maintain a central registry of head-injured disabled persons. 8 (a)(1) The Department of Health shall establish and maintain a central 9 registry of persons with a disability resulting from a traumatic head injury. 10 (2) The department may grant or contract services to ensure 11 services and the tracking of persons with a disability resulting from a 12 traumatic head injury. (b)(1)(A) Every public and private health and social agency and 13 14 attending physician hospital in the Arkansas Trauma System shall report to 15 the alliance department or authorized agent of the department within five (5) 16 calendar days after an identification of any head-injured disabled person all 17 persons with a disability resulting from a traumatic head injury. 18 (B) However, the consent of the individual shall be 19 obtained before making this report, except that every head injury resulting 20 in permanent partial, permanent total, or total disability shall be reported 21 to the alliance immediately upon identification The notification of the 22 report described in subdivision (b)(l)(A) of this section shall be provided 23 to the individual or the family of the individual after the hospital makes 24 the report and the individual or the family may exercise the option to be 25 removed from future communications. 26 (2) The report <u>described</u> in <u>subdivision</u> (b)(1)(A) of this 27 section shall contain the name, age, residence, and type of disability of the 28 individual and such additional information as may be deemed necessary by the 29 alliance department. 30 (3)(A) Within fifteen (15) days of the report and identification of a head-injured person, the alliance shall furnish the Department of Health 31 all available information for use in any information system on injuries 32 33 maintained by the department. (B) The alliance shall not release the identity of the 34 35 patient, reporting physician, or hospital. However, the identity of the

patient shall be released upon written consent of the patient or parent or

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guardian of the patient, the identity of the reporting physician shall be released upon written consent of the reporting physician, and the identity of the hospital shall be released upon written consent of the hospital.

- 20-14-704. Rehabilitative services.
- (a) Within fifteen (15) thirty (30) business days of the report and identification of a head injured disabled person persons with a disability resulting from a traumatic head injury under § 20-14-703, the Brain Injury Alliance of Arkansas Department of Health or an authorized agent of the department shall notify the disabled person or the most immediate family members of their right to assistance from the state, the services available, and the eligibility requirements.
 - (b) The alliance department or an authorized agent of the department shall refer severely disabled persons a person with a disability resulting from a traumatic head injury to appropriate divisions, departments, and other state agencies to ensure that maximum available rehabilitative services, if desired, are obtained by the head-injured disabled person person with a disability resulting from a traumatic head injury.
 - (c) All other agencies of the state shall cooperate with the Governor's Commission on People with Disabilities department or an authorized agent of the department to ensure that appropriate total rehabilitative and other services are available.
