SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHARED SERVICES. (a)(1) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State may create a Shared Services paying accounts on his or her books and on the books of the Treasurer of State and the Auditor of State for the payment of personal services and operating expenses in the Shared Services Paying Account Appropriation by the Department of Inspector General.

(2) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the transfer

- 1 of funds and appropriations to the Shared Services Paying Account
- 2 appropriation section of this act on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
- 3 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
- 4 (3) The transfer authority provided to the department in

14	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
