25	SECTION 1. Arkansas	Code § 23-18-504(a), conce	erning exemptions under
26	the Utility Facility Environmental and Economic Protection Act, is amended to		
27	add an additional subdivision to read as follows:		
28	<u>(6) That is a</u>	gas pipeline constructed:	
29	<u>(A) Prim</u>	narily for serving a single	e customer or a group of
30	customers that is under common ownership or control; and		
31	(B) Enti	rely on land:	
32	<u>(i)</u>	Owned by the customer or	r group of customers to
33	be served; or		
34	<u>(ii</u>) Leased by the customer	or group of customers to
35	be served if the lease is entered to facilitate the issuance of bonds under

2	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the			
3	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the inflation rate is high,			
4	with the consumer price index for all items increasing six and five-tenths			
5	percent (6.5%) and food items increasing ten and four-tenths percent (10.4%)			
6	over the last twelve (12) months according to the United States Bureau of			
7	Labor Statistics; that many Arkansans are in need of jobs in this economy;			
8	and that this act is immediately necessary because commencement of			
9	construction on pipelines will make jobs available to the people of Arkansas			
10	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately			
11	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall			
12	become effective on:			
13	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;			
14	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,			
15	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the			
16	bill; or			
17	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is			
18	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
