23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
26 for the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the
27 2023-2024 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

23 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 24 the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the 2023-
 25 2024 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 26 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 27 herein for such purposes: thirty-one (31) temporary or part-time employees,
 28 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 29 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 30 appropriate classification.

31

32 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 33 to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council, to be
 34 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services,
 35 operating expenses, contingency, committee rooms, and construction and
 36 capital improvements of the Bureau of Legislative Research and the

 30 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative
 31 Council Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State Central Services
 32 Fund, for paying per diem, expenses and mileage to members of the Arkansas
 33 General Assembly attending regular and special meetings and other committee
 34 related activities of the Ad Interim Committees of the Arkansas General
 35 Assembly, and for out-of-state travel expenses for committee staff as
 36 approved by the appropriate committee for the fiscal year ending June 30,

14 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - ENERGY COUNCIL. There is hereby
 15 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative
 16 Council Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State Central Services
 17 Fund, for paying expenses of members of the Arkansas General Assembly
 18 attending meetings of the Energy Council and for other associated expenses
 19 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, the following:

26 SECTION 7. REAPPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Bureau
 27 of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council, to be payable from the
 28 State Central Services Fund, from the balance of the appropriation remaining
 29 on June 30, 2023 in Sections 3 and 7 of Act 9 of 2022, there to be used to
 30 the same purposes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024, in a sum not to
 31 exceed.....\$2,000,000.

33 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

35 SPECIAL LANGUAGE – CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code § 10-3-303, concerning the
 36 Bureau of Legislative Research, is amended to add additional subsections to

1 read as follows:

2 (i) The director may direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to
 3 transfer appropriation between the following in such amounts as are
 4 determined to be necessary:

5 (1) The line items within appropriations pertaining to the
 6 bureau; and

7 (2) The appropriations made by the operative appropriation act
 8 for the bureau.

9 (j)(1) Any adjustments in annual salary rates for employees of the
 10 bureau, labor market adjustments, merit pay adjustments, or employee
 11 retention or recruitment requirements shall be made at the discretion of the
 12 director.

13 (2)(A) Salary payments under this subsection shall not be
 14 restricted to maximum amounts authorized by law.

15 (B) If salary adjustments under this subsection exceed the
 16 maximum line item amount authorized by law for a position, the amount shall
 17 be paid to the employee as a lump-sum payment.

18 (k)(1) The director shall be the disbursing officer for the funds
 19 appropriated by the operative appropriation act for the bureau, including the
 20 Interim Committee Study Expenses section of the operative appropriation act
 21 for the bureau.

22 (2) The director shall appoint a designee who shall serve as the
 23 disbursing officer in his or her absence.

24 (3) In the event there is no director, the co-chairs of the
 25 Legislative Council may appoint a disbursing officer.

26 (l) All expenditures from the appropriations provided by the operative
 27 appropriation act for the bureau shall be in accordance with:

28 (1) Procedures established by the Legislative Council; and

29 (2) Appropriate law.

30

31 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

33 CLASSIFICATION UTILIZATION. The Bureau of Legislative Research may utilize,
 34 at the discretion of the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research, the
 35 following classifications as necessary. The use of these classifications
 36 shall not be considered as increasing the number of positions authorized in

1 this act, only as a temporary reclassification or cross grade of a position.

36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2022~~

1 2023 through June 30, ~~2023~~ 2024.

2
3 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
4 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
6 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
12

13 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
21

22 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
23 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
24 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of
26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
