2	noncompliance with this section shall be referred to the Professional
3	Licensure Standards Board by filing a formal complaint.
4	(b) Upon the board finding noncompliance with
5	this section as applicable, the licensed personnel shall be subject to a
6	minimum sanction of a one (1) year suspension, up to the revocation of his on
7	her license, as determined by the board.
8	(iii)(a) For nonlicensed personnel or a registered
9	volunteer, an allegation of noncompliance with this section shall be referred
10	to the Arkansas Activities Association by filing a formal complaint.
11	(b) Upon the Arkansas Activities Association
12	finding noncompliance with this section as applicable, a nonlicensed
13	personnel or registered volunteer shall be subject to a minimum sanction of a
14	one (1) year suspension, up to the revocation of an Arkansas Activities
15	Association endorsement, as determined by the Arkansas Activities
16	Association.
17	(iv)(a) As used in this section, "recruiting" means
18	the use of undue influence or special inducement by an individual who is
19	connected directly or indirectly with a school that is a member of the
20	Arkansas Activities Association in an attempt to encourage, induce, pressure,
21	urge, or entice a prospective student of any age to transfer to the school or
22	retain a student at the school for the purpose of participating in
23	extracurricular activities.
24	(b) However, an individual who coaches or
25	assists with coaching an extracurricular activity sponsored by a school that
26	employs the individual is not recruiting for purposes of this section if he
27	or she coaches or assists with coaching during an off-season program that is
28	separate from the extracurricular activity sponsored by the school that
29	employs the individual.
30	(3) As used in subdivision (m)(1) of this section,
31	"extracurricular activity" means an interschool activity not included in a
32	regular curriculum, including without limitation sports and special interest
33	clubs or groups.
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35	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-18-1904, concerning general provisions
36	for student transfers under the Public School Choice Act of 2015 is amended

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1	to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
2	(f)(1) A student who transfers to another public school or a
3	nonresident district under this subchapter shall not be:
4	(A) Denied participation in an extracurricular activity at
5	the public school or nonresident district to which he or she transfers based
6	exclusively on his or her decision to transfer to the public school or
7	nonresident district; or
8	(B) Disciplined in any manner based exclusively on the
9	exercise of his or her right to transfer to another public school or a
10	nonresident district under this subchapter.
11	(2)(A) However, a student who transfers to another public school
12	or a nonresident school district under this subchapter shall complete a
13	Changing Schools/Athletic Participation form as defined by the Arkansas
14	Activities Association.
15	(B) A Changing Schools/Athletic Participation form shall
16	be completed and filed with the:
17	(i) Public school or nonresident school district to
18	which the student transfers under this section; and
19	(ii) Arkansas Activities Association.
20	(C)(i) Before a student is eligible to participate in an
21	extracurricular activity at the public school or nonresident school district
22	to which he or she transfers, the Changing Schools/Athletic Participation
23	form submitted by the student as required under subdivision (f)(2)(B) of this
24	section shall be signed by the:
