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27	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 2-33-102	(d), concerning vacanc	ies in the
28	membership of the Arkansas Livestock and	Poultry Commission, is	amended to
29	read as follows:

31	reason other than expiration of the terms	for which the members	were
32	appointed shall be filled by appointment I	y the Governor and be	effective
33	until the expiration of the terms, subject	to the confirmation o	of the Senate
34	when it is next in session.		
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36	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-3-102	b), concerning vacanci	es in the



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1 membership of the Arkansas Educational Television Commission, is amended to 2 read as follows: 3 (b)(1) Members of the commission shall be appointed by the Governor 4 with the advice and consent of the Senate for terms of eight (8) years. 5 Members of the commission shall be eligible for (2) 6 reappointment. 7 (3) If a vacancy occurs at a time when the Senate is in session, 8 the Governor shall, with the advice and consent of the Senate, appoint 9 another member of the commission for the unexpired term. 10 (4) If a vacancy occurs when the Senate is not in session, the 11 Governor shall appoint a member of the commission who shall take office 12 immediately, but his or her appointment shall be subject to confirmation by 13 the Senate at the next session of the General Assembly. 14 (5) If the appointment of such member of the commission is 15 confirmed by the Senate, he or she shall serve the remainder of the unexpired 16 term. 17 18 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-43-101(d)(2), concerning submission of 19 appointments of members of the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas School for 20 the Blind and the Arkansas School for the Deaf, is amended to read as 21 follows: 22 (2)(A) The Governor shall submit to the Senate for approval, on or 23 before the fourteenth day following the commencement of each regular session of the General Assembly, the names of all unconfirmed appointments made by 24 25 him or her to fill expired terms and the names of appointments to fill the 26 terms expiring during the regular session of the General Assembly within ten 27 (10) days following the appointment. 28 (B) The members appointed by the Governor to fill 29 vacancies caused by the expiration of the terms of members may qualify and 30 hold office until the appointments are rejected by the Senate. 31 32 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-65-201(d)(2), concerning submission of 33 appointments of members of the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas State 34 University system, is amended to read as follows: 35 (2) On or before the fourteenth day following the commencement of each 36 regular session of the General Assembly, the The Governor shall submit to the

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Senate for approval the names of all unconfirmed appointments made by him or her to fill expired terms and the names of appointments to fill the terms expiring during the regular session of the General Assembly within ten (10) days following the appointment. The members appointed by the Governor to fill vacancies caused by the expiration of the terms of members may qualify and hold office until the appointments are rejected by the Senate.

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8 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 6-65-301(d)(2), concerning submission of 9 appointments of members of the Board of Trustees of Southern Arkansas 10 University, is amended to read as follows:

11 The Governor shall submit to the Senate for approval, on or before (2) 12 the fourteenth day following the commencement of each regular session of the 13 General Assembly the names of all unconfirmed appointments made by him or her 14 to fill expired terms and the names of appointments to fill the terms 15 expiring during the regular session of the General Assembly within ten (10) 16 days following the appointment. The members appointed by the Governor to fill 17 vacancies caused by the expiration of the terms of members may qualify and 18 hold office until the appointments are rejected by the Senate. 19

20 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 6-65-401(g), concerning vacancies in the 21 membership of the Board of Trustees of Southern Arkansas University, is 22 amended to read as follows:

(g) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the board for any reason other than the expiration of the regular terms for which the members were appointed shall be filled by the appointment of the Governor, subject to the approval by a majority of the remaining members of the board and shall be thereafter effective until the expiration of the regular term unless the appointment is rejected by the Senate at the next regular session of the General Assembly.

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31 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 6-67-102(d)(2), concerning submission of 32 appointments of members of the Board of Trustees of the University of Central 33 Arkansas, is amended to read as follows:

34 (2) The Governor shall submit to the Senate for approval, on or before
 35 the fourteenth day following the commencement of each regular session of the
 36 General Assembly, the names of all unconfirmed appointments made by him or

her to fill expired terms and the names of appointments to fill the terms expiring during the regular session of the General Assembly within ten (10) days following the appointment. The members appointed by the Governor to fill vacancies caused by the expiration of the terms of members may qualify and hold office until the appointments are rejected by the Senate.

SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 8-4-104(d), concerning vacancies in the
membership of the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission, is
amended to read as follows:

10 (d) In the event of a vacancy in the membership of the Arkansas 11 Pollution Control and Ecology Commission, the Governor shall appoint a person 12 to fill the vacancy temporarily who shall serve until the next meeting of the 13 Senate, when some person shall be appointed by the Covernor, by and with the 14 consent and approval of the Senate, to serve the remainder of the unexpired 15 term.

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SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 10-2-113 is amended to read as follows: 10-2-113. Senate confirmation of board and commission appointees.

(a) All appointments made by the Governor of members of boards and commissions of the State of Arkansas, except appointments of members of boards and commissions governed by specific constitutional provisions that may be in conflict with this section, shall be subject to confirmation by the Senate. However, if any such appointment is made while the General Assembly is not in session, the The person so appointed may qualify and hold office until the appointment shall be rejected by the Senate.

26 (b)(1) The Governor shall submit to the Senate within thirty (30) 27 days after the General Assembly convenes in a regular session and within 28 fifteen (15) days after the General Assembly convenes in a fiscal session the 29 names of all appointments to boards and commissions of this state made 30 subsequent to adjournment of the Senate at the last regular session or fiscal 31 session of the General Assembly within ten (10) days following the 32 appointment for the consideration of confirmation by the Senate. 33 (2) Upon the convening of a special session of the General 34 Assembly, the Governor shall immediately submit the names of all appointments

35 to boards and commissions of this state made subsequent to adjournment of the

36 Senate at the last regular session, fiscal session, or special session of the

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1 General Assembly. 2 (3) All appointments of members of boards and commissions of 3 this state made while the General Assembly is in session shall be submitted 4 immediately to the Senate. 5 (c) If an appointment is rejected by the Senate, the person rejected 6 shall not thereafter be eligible to serve in the position or exercise the 7 powers of the position, unless the appointment of the person is first 8 approved by the Senate. 9 10 SECTION 10. Arkansas Code Title 10, Chapter 2, Subchapter 1 is amended 11 to add a new section to read as follows: 12 10-2-134. Senate confirmation of gubernatorial appointments. 13 (a) The Governor shall submit the names of all appointments for which 14 Senate confirmation is required by law to the Senate within ten (10) days 15 following the appointment. 16 (b) During the interim between legislative sessions, the President Pro 17 Tempore of the Senate shall call a Senate business meeting at least one (1) 18 time every three (3) months to consider recommendations from the Rules 19 Committee of the Senate regarding confirmation of gubernatorial appointments. 20 (c) During a regular session, fiscal session, or extraordinary session of the General Assembly, the Senate shall consider confirmation of 21 22 gubernatorial appointments in accordance with the Rules of the Senate.

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SECTION 11. Arkansas Code § 10-3-212(a), concerning interim meetings
of the Rules Committee of the House of Representatives and the Rules
Committee of the Senate, is amended to read as follows:

27 (a)(1) The Rules Committee of the Senate and the Rules Committee of 28 the House of Representatives are authorized to meet jointly or separately at 29 any time during the interim between legislative sessions as the Rules 30 Committee of the Senate and the Rules Committee of the House of 31 Representatives shall deem necessary or desirable to review the Rules of the 32 Senate, the Rules of the House of Representatives, and the Joint Rules of the 33 House of Representatives and the Senate and to make recommendations for 34 revisions in the rules or new rules as the Rules Committee of the Senate and 35 the Rules Committee of the House of Representatives shall deem appropriate. 36 (2) In addition to meeting under subdivision (a)(1) of this

1 section, the Rules Committee of the Senate is authorized to meet during the 2 interim between legislative sessions to: 3 (A) Consider gubernatorial appointments; and 4 (B) Make recommendations to the Senate regarding confirmation 5 of appointments under subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section. 6 7 SECTION 12. Arkansas Code § 11-2-107(b)(4), concerning timing of the 8 appointment of the Director of the Division of Labor, is repealed. 9 (4) All appointments made while the Senate is not in regular session shall be effective ad interim. 10 11 12 SECTION 13. Arkansas Code § 12-8-102(c)(1), concerning vacancies in 13 the membership of the Arkansas State Police Commission, is amended to read as 14 follows: 15 (c)(1) When vacancies occur in the commission, the Governor may 16 temporarily fill the position consistent with subsection (b) of this section 17 until the Senate is next in session. 18 19 SECTION 14. Arkansas Code § 12-12-302(a)(2)(B), concerning vacancies 20 in the membership of the State Crime Laboratory Board, is amended to read as 21 follows: 22 (B) However, a vacancy may be temporarily filled by the 23 Governor until the Senate shall next meet subject to confirmation of the 24 Senate. 25 26 SECTION 15. Arkansas Code § 12-62-101(b), concerning appointment and 27 confirmation of general officers above the grade of brigadier general of the Arkansas National Guard, is amended to read as follows: 28 29 (b) General officers above the grade of brigadier general shall be appointed and promoted by the Governor with the consent of the Senate. During 30 31 the time that the Senate is not in session, the Covernor may make such 32 appointments subject to subsequent confirmation by the Senate. 33 34 SECTION 16. Arkansas Code § 13-3-102(c), concerning vacancies in the 35 membership of the Arkansas History Commission, is amended to read as follows: 36 (c) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for any

1 reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which the members were 2 appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, and to be 3 thereafter effective until the expiration of the regular terms, subject, 4 however, to the confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session. 5

6 SECTION 17. Arkansas Code § 13-3-202(d), concerning vacancies in the 7 membership of the Black History Commission of Arkansas, is amended to read as 8 follows:

9 (d) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for any 10 reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which the members were 11 appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, and to be 12 thereafter effective until the expiration of the regular terms, subject, 13 however, to the confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session. 14

15 SECTION 18. Arkansas Code § 14-118-203(d), concerning vacancies in the 16 membership of the Red River Commission, is amended to read as follows:

(d) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for any reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which the members were appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, and to be thereafter effective until the expiration of the regular terms, subject, however, to the confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session.

23 SECTION 19. Arkansas Code § 15-4-202(c), concerning vacancies in the 24 membership of the Arkansas Economic Development Council, is amended to read 25 as follows:

(c) A vacancy arising in the membership of the council appointed by the Governor for any reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which the members were appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor to be thereafter effective until the expiration of the terms, subject to the confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session.

32 SECTION 20. Arkansas Code § 15-11-202(f), concerning vacancies in the 33 membership of the State Parks, Recreation, and Travel Commission, is amended 34 to read as follows:

35 (f) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for any 36 reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which members were

1 appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor and be thereafter 2 effective until the expiration of their regular terms, subject, however, to 3 the confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session.

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5 SECTION 21. Arkansas Code § 15-20-202(d), concerning vacancies in the 6 membership of the Arkansas Natural Resources Commission, is amended to read 7 as follows:

8 (d) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for any 9 reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which such members were 10 appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor and to be thereafter 11 effective until the expiration of those terms, subject, however, to the 12 confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session.

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SECTION 22. Arkansas Code § 15-31-102(c), concerning vacancies in the membership of the Arkansas Forestry Commission, is amended to read as follows:

17 (c)(1) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the commission for 18 any reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which the members 19 were appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor.

20 (2) Appointments shall be thereafter effective until the
21 expiration of the regular terms, subject, however, to the confirmation of the
22 Senate when it is next in session.

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24 SECTION 23. Arkansas Code § 15-55-202(d), concerning vacancies in the 25 membership of the Arkansas Geological Survey, is amended to read as follows:

(d) Any vacancies arising in the membership of the survey for any reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which the members were appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, to be thereafter effective until the expiration of the regular terms, subject, however, to the confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session.

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32 SECTION 24. Arkansas Code § 16-93-201(b), concerning vacancies in the 33 membership of the Parole Board, is amended to read as follows:

(b) If any vacancy occurs on the board prior to the expiration of a
term, the Governor shall fill the vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired
term, subject to confirmation by the Senate at its next regular session.

2 SECTION 25. Arkansas Code § 17-50-201(d), concerning vacancies in the 3 membership of the Commission on Water Well Construction, is amended to read 4 as follows:

5 (d) Any vacancies arising on the membership of the commission for any 6 reason other than expiration of the regular terms for which the members were 7 appointed shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, to be effective 8 until the expiration of the regular terms, subject, however, to the 9 confirmation of the Senate when it is next in session.

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SECTION 26. Arkansas Code § 25-16-804(b)(1), concerning removal and replacement of a state board or commission member, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) The Governor may remove for good cause a state board or commission member whose office or position is filled by gubernatorial appointment, subject to confirmation by the Senate. If the Senate is not in session, confirmation shall be by written petition of a majority of the senators.

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20 SECTION 27. Arkansas Code § 27-89-201 is amended to read as follows:
 21 27-89-201. Creation of commission - Members.

(a) The Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,
shall appoint three (3) commissioners to enter into a compact on behalf of
the State of Arkansas with the State of Mississippi.

25 (b) If the Senate is not in session at the time for making these 26 appointments, the Governor shall make temporary appointments, as in the case 27 of a vacancy.

28 (c) Any two (2) of the commissioners so appointed, together with the 29 Attorney General of the State of Arkansas, may act to enter into the compact 30 set out in § 27-89-202.

31 (d)(c) Vacancies occurring in the office of any appointed commissioner 32 shall be filled by appointment by the Governor by and with the advice and 33 consent of the Senate for the unexpired term.

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35 SECTION 28. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the</u>
 36 <u>General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the positions to which the</u>

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1	Governor makes appointments are important and necessary to the functions of
2	the government of the State of Arkansas; with a change in the administration
3	of the government of the State of Arkansas due to a new Governor taking
4	office on January 10, 2023, there are many vacancies on boards and
5	commissions in the state to be filled by the Governor's appointees; it is
6	imperative that the Senate consider confirmation of the appointments near in
7	time to when the appointments occur, whether that be during a legislative
8	session or the interim between legislative sessions, in order to avoid
9	continued vacancies; and that this act is immediately necessary to provide
10	for the expeditious review and confirmation of gubernatorial appointments in
11	order to fill the positions that are necessary to the functioning of state
12	government and the protection of the public health, welfare, and safety of
13	the citizens of the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
14	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
15	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:
16	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
17	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
18	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
19	bill; or
20	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
21	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
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
