8	person convicted of a violation of § 27-66-501 shall be civilly liable to the		
9	proper county or road improvement district for the following recoverable		
10	damages, including without limitation:		
11	(1) The cost of replacement of the public bridge or part of the		
12	public bridge without factoring in depreciation of the destroyed public		
13	bridge;		
14	(2) The cost of removal of the damaged structure or debris; and		
15	(3) Costs and reasonable attorneys fees incurred in the pursuit		
16	and collection of the recoverable damages available under this section.		
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
