30	(C) The foster placement of an infant under one (1) year

33	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 21-4-214(e)(1)-(3), concerning the	
34	catastrophic leave program and maternity leave, are amended to read as

36	(e)(1) Up to $\frac{\text{four (4)}}{\text{twelve (12)}}$ consecutive weeks of catastrophic

1	leave with full pay may be granted to an employee for maternity purposes.
2	(2) The employee shall be eligible for the leave only within the
3	first twelve (12) weeks after the birth, foster, or adoption of a child.
4	(3) After the expiration of the $\frac{\text{four (4)}}{\text{twelve (12)}}$ weeks of
5	leave under subdivision (e)(1) of this section, maternity leave shall be
6	treated as any other leave for sickness or disability under § 21-4-209.
