## Subtitle

TO REPEAL THE LAW THAT PROHIBITS LEAVING  
A RUNNING VEHICLE UNATTENDED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1306 is repealed.

~~27-51-1306. Unattended motor vehicles.~~

~~No person driving or in charge of a motor vehicle shall permit it to  
stand unattended without first stopping the engine, locking the ignition, and  
removing the key, or, when standing upon any perceptible grade, without  
effectively setting the brake and turning the front wheels to the curb or  
side of the highway.~~
