SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-101-102(11)(B)(ii), concerning the definition of "veterinarian-client-patient relationship" is amended to read as follows:

(ii)(a) This means that the veterinarian has recently seen and is personally acquainted with the keeping and care of the animal, by virtue of an examination, whether in-person or by telemedicine, of the animal or by medically appropriate and timely visits to the premises animal is kept.

(b) If a veterinarian is using telemedicine, the veterinarian shall be licensed in this state and a resident of this state as defined under § 26-51-102(13); and
