TRANSFER 8 OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. The Chief Fiscal Officer 9 of the State shall transfer funds in an amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal 10 year ending June 30, 2023 2024 from the Department of Human Services - Youth 11 Services Fund Account to the Juvenile Detention Facilities Operating Fund to 12 fund the appropriation to the Department of Finance and Administration -13 Disbursing Officer for grants for operating expenses of local juvenile 14 detention facilities.

(e)(1) The Division of Youth Services may use the administrative
 operating account for capital improvements to the physical plant and the
 purchase of capital equipment by the Mansfield Juvenile Treatment Center
 operated by the Division of Youth Services.

31 (2) The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to

33 (A) To finance capital improvements to the physical plant;

35 (B) For the purchase of major capital equipment by the

19	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.					
20	RESIDENTIAL SERVICES CONTINGENCY. If it has been determined that the					
21	Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services cannot continue to					
22	contract with private provider(s) for residential juvenile services,					
23	educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical services and deems					
24	it necessary to utilize Department staff to provide all or parts of the					
25	required services above, the Department is authorized to seek the approval of					
26	the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the Arkansas					
27	Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to utilize the contingent					
28	residential services positions contained in this Act and to make the					
29	appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL					
30	SERVICES appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the					
31	OPERATIONS appropriation of this Act. If it has been determined that the					
32	Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services cannot continue to					
33	operate one or more of the various service components of a Residential					
34	Facility for residential juvenile services, educational services, therapeutic					
35	services, and/or medical services and deems it necessary to utilize a					
36	contract with private provider(s), the Department is authorized to seek the					

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approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the
Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to make the
appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the OPERATIONS
appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL
SERVICES appropriation of this Act.

6 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
7 2022 2023 through June 30, 2023 2024.

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SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA 11 HELP SALARIES - CONTINGENT RESIDENTIAL SERVICES POSITIONS. There is hereby 12 established for the Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services - Contingent Residential Services Positions, the following maximum number of 13 14 positions whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform 15 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code § 21-5-201 et seq.), or 16 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Requests to use positions 17 will be based upon the non-contracted services for residential juvenile 18 services, educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical 19 services. If at such time a category(s) of services are contracted with 20 private provider(s), identified positions associated with such service(s) 21 shall be returned to the contingency pool. In order to ensure required 22 staffing levels, Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically 23 exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or regulation. 24

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35 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

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and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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9 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17

18 SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of 21 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm 24 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023. 28 29 30 31 32 33

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
