25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GEN	ERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF	ARKANSAS:

27	SECTION 1. Arkans	as Code § 20-16-602(c), concer	rning the Right-to-Know-
28	and-See Act, is amended	to read as follows:	
29	(c)(l) An abortio	n provider who knowingly perfo	orms <u>or refers for</u> an
30	abortion shall comply wi	th the requirements of this se	ection.
31	(2) Before a	pregnant woman gives informed	d consent to an abortion
32	or is <u>referred for or</u> ad	ministered any anesthesia or m	nedication in
33	preparation of an aborti	on, the physician or qualified	d technician shall:
34	(A) Pe	rform an obstetric ultrasound	on the pregnant woman
35	using a method that the	physician and the pregnant wom	nan agree is best under
36	the circumstances;		

1	(B)(i) Provide a simultaneous verbal explanation of what		
2	the ultrasound is depicting that includes the presence and location of the		
3	unborn child within the uterus and the number of unborn children depicted.		
4	(ii) If the ultrasound image indicates that the		
5	unborn child has died, the physician or qualified technician shall inform th		
6	pregnant woman of that fact;		
7	(C) Display the ultrasound images so that the pregnant		
8	woman may view them and document in the pregnant woman's medical record that		
9	the ultrasound images were displayed to the pregnant woman;		
10	(D) Provide a medical description of the ultrasound		
11	images, including the dimensions of the unborn child and the presence of		
12	external members and internal organs if present and viewable; and		
13	(E) Retain the ultrasound image with the date that the		
14	ultrasound occurred in the pregnant woman's medical record.

16	SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. <u>SEVERABILITY CLAUSE</u> . If any provision of		
17	this act or the application of this act to any person or circumstance is held		
18	invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of		
19	this act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or		
20	application, and to this end, the provisions of this act are declared		
21	severable.
