These positions are to be used by the 21 Department of Education in the event that the personal services needs of the 22 Department during the 2022-2023 2023-2024 fiscal year require additional 23 positions, either by title or in number, that are not authorized by the 24 General Assembly in the Regular Salaries section of this Act. These positions 25 may also be used to properly classify positions when the Department does not 26 have a vacant position available with the appropriate title and salary level.
 - (b) To address needs emerging from statewide education issues and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified personnel, the Arkansas Department of Education or its successor agency is authorized for the 2022-2023 2023-2024 fiscal year a pool of ten (10) General Salaries positions at up to a grade GS15. These positions are to be used by the Department of Education in the event that the personal services needs of the Department during the 2022-2023 2023-2024 fiscal year require additional positions, either by classification or in number, that are not authorized by the General Assembly in the Regular Salaries section of this Act. These positions may also be used to properly classify positions when the Department does not have

1 a vacant position available with the appropriate title and grade level.
