22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-89-102(4), concerning the	definition of
23	B "ophthalmic dispensing", is amended to read as follows:	
24	(4)(A) "Ophthalmic dispensing" means the preparate	ion of
25	laboratory work orders, verification, and dispensing of specta	cle lenses,
26	spectacles, eyeglasses, or parts thereof, or contact lenses, to	o the intended
27	wearer on a written prescription from a licensed physician ski	lled in disease
28	of the eye or from a licensed optometrist.	
29	(B) " Opthalmic <u>Ophthalmic</u> dispensing" shall	-include
30	includes:	
31	(i) The measuring, fitting, adapting,	and adjusting
32	of spectacle lenses, spectacles, eyeglasses, or parts thereof	to the human
33	B face;	
34	(ii) The preparation and delivery of v	work orders to
35	laboratory technicians engaged in grinding lenses and fabricat	ion of eyewear;

6	(C) The prescribing, adapting, fitting, duplicating,	
7	dispensing, or modifying, selling, or supplying of contact lenses for or to

10	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-89-104(d), concerning the prohibition of	
11	the practice of optometry or medicine by licensed dispensing opticians, is	
12	amended to read as follows:	
13	(d) The prescribing, adapting, fitting, duplicating, dispensing, or	
14	modifying, selling, or supplying of contact lenses for or to the human eye is	
15	specifically prohibited except when done by a licensed optometrist or	
16	licensed physician skilled in disease of the eye.
