BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

28 SECTION 45. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

30 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish
31 upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional
32 Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items.
33 When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its
34 operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be
35 forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer
36 of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas

1 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum
2 number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general
3 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the
4 General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums
5 in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue
6 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the
7 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that
8 the Arkansas Agriculture Department may operate more efficiently if some
9 flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department authorizing
10 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
11 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
12 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by
13 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or
14 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the
15 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
16 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
17 section is void.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2022~~
19 2023 through June 30, ~~2023~~ 2024.

20
21 SECTION 46. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

30
31 SECTION 47. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
32 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
33 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
34 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
35 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
36 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
2 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

3
4 SECTION 48. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
5 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
6 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
10 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
11 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
12 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
13 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
14 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
