The Commission for Parent Counsel 8 shall have the authority to use the appropriation provided in line item 9 Parent Counsel Reimbursements of the Parent Counsel Program appropriation 10 herein for the purpose of entering into independent professional service 11 contracts on a full-time or part-time basis with attorneys who are qualified 12 to provide counsel for indigent parents in dependency-neglect cases. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2022 14 2023 through June 30, 2023 2024.

Employees currently working on a part-time basis may be utilized concurrently as Extra Help within the agency. 6	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
7	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
8	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
9	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

11	SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
12	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
13	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
14	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2023 is essential to the operation of
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
17	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2023 could work irreparable harm
18	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
19	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
20	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
21	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2023.
