Each course of instruction shall consist of not fewer than four (4) 6 terms and of not fewer than thirty two (32) weeks of six (6) days for each 7 term; 8 (3) It shall possess apparatus and equipment adequate and 9 sufficient for the ready and full teaching of the foregoing subjects; and 10 (4) It shall be recognized as being reputable by the American 11 Dental Association Council before being recognized as such by the board. 12 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-82-302(3)-(5), concerning the exemptions 13 14 to the licensure for dentistry, are amended to read as follows: 15 (3)(A) Acts that would otherwise constitute practicing dentistry 16 or the practice of dentistry or dental hygiene by students under the 17 supervision of instructors in any dental college, university, hospital or 18 institution, or dental department of any college, university, hospital or 19 institution, or school of dental hygiene in this state that is recognized as 20 being reputable by the Council on Dental Education and Licensure of the 21 American Dental Association accredited by the Commission on Dental 22 Accreditation and approved by the Arkansas State Board of Dental Examiners or 23 an affiliated site of a dental college, university, hospital or institution, 24 or school of dental hygiene that is accredited by the Commission on Dental 25 Accreditation and approved by the board. 26 (B) The acts described in subdivision (3)(A) of this 27 section are those performed within the educational facility incident to a 28 course of study or training and are not carried on for personal profit; 29 (4)(A) Acts that would otherwise constitute the practice of 30 practicing dentistry by a graduate of a college of dentistry approved by the 31 board who is engaged in an internship or residency program in a dental 32 college, university, hospital or institution, or dental department of any 33 college, university, hospital or institution in this state that is recognized 34 as reputable by the Council on Dental Education and Licensure of the American 35 Dental Association accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation and 36 approved by the board or an affiliated site of a dental college, university,

1	hospital or institution, or school of dental hygiene that is accredited by		
2	the Commission on Dental Accreditation and approved by the board.		
3	(B) The acts described in subdivision $(4)(A)$ of this		
4	section are those performed within the facility pursuant to the internship or		
5	residency program, and the intern or resident serves without fee or		
6	compensation other than that received in salary or other authorized		
7	allowances;		
8	(5) (A) Acts that would otherwise constitute the practice of		
9	practicing dentistry by a graduate of a college of dentistry approved by the		
10	board who is engaged in teaching dentistry in a dental college, university,		
11	hospital or institution, or dental department of any college, university,		
12	hospital or institution in this state that is recognized as reputable by the		
13	Council on Dental Education and Licensure of the American Dental Association		
14	accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation and approved by the		
15	board or an affiliated site of a dental college, university, hospital or		
16	institution, or school of dental hygiene that is accredited by the Commission		
17	on Dental Accreditation and approved by the board.		
18	(B) The acts described in subdivision (5)(A) of this		
19	section are those performed within the facility pursuant to the teaching		
20	appointment, and the person serves without fee or compensation other than		
21	that received in salary or other authorized allowances;
