WHEREAS, in exchange for their service, AmeriCorps members develop valuable work skills, earn money for continuing education, and strengthen the lives of their families, their communities, and the state as a whole; and WHEREAS, since AmeriCorps was founded in 1993, more than eleven thousand (11,000) residents in Arkansas have served approximately eighteen million (18,000,000) hours through AmeriCorps and have received higher education and loan reimbursement from the Segal AmeriCorps Education Award totaling more than thirty-six million dollars (\$36,000,000); and WHEREAS, AmeriCorps Week is an opportunity to recognize the dedication and commitment of the more than one million (1,000,000) Americans who have chosen to serve their country through AmeriCorps and their community partners, and to encourage more Americans to follow their footsteps in service, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: THAT the Senate thank AmeriCorps members for their service and proclaim the week of March 13-17, 2023, as AmeriCorps Week in Arkansas.
