22 her nursing career at the Arkansas State Hospital LPTN psychiatric nursing
23 program; and

25 WHEREAS, Brenda Huett later enrolled in the Baptist System School of
26 Registered Nursing in conjunction with Henderson State University; and

28 WHEREAS, Brenda Huett worked for Arkansas Children's Hospital in the
29 behavioral health care of both children and adolescents and occasionally
30 worked in the hospital's burn unit; and

32 WHEREAS, Brenda Huett worked at Arkansas Children's Hospital for
33 fifteen (15) years; and

35 WHEREAS, after leaving Arkansas Children's Hospital, Brenda Huett
36 worked at the Community Mental Health Center for eight (8) years in a

3 WHEREAS, during her time at the Community Mental Health Center, Brenda
4 Huett received her Psychiatric Certification from the American Nurses
5 Credentialing Center; and

7 WHEREAS, after leaving the Community Mental Health Center, Brenda Huett
8 worked as a traveling nurse for ten (10) years; and

9
10 WHEREAS, Brenda Huett enjoyed traveling nursing and the different
11 assignments she took on and the places she was able to explore, including
12 assignments in:

- 13 (1) Maine;
14 (2) The Virgin Islands;
15 (3) Hawaii;
16 (4) Louisiana;
17 (5) Nebraska; and
18 (6) Tennessee; and

20 WHEREAS, after working as a traveling nurse, Brenda Huett decided to
21 stay closer to home and accepted a job with the Department of Health's
22 regional flu team, working during flu season for the last ten (10) years; and

23
24 WHEREAS, Brenda Huett has also been working as a nurse in the H. Elvin
25 Shuffield Capitol Infirmary during the legislative sessions for ten (10)
26 years; and

28 WHEREAS, Brenda Huett is a member of the National Nurses Honor Guard
29 Coalition and is active in the Saline County Chapter, feeling honored to be a
30 part of an organization that honors her fellow nurses; and

32 WHEREAS, Brenda Huett has dedicated her professional career to nursing
33 and caring for the citizens of Arkansas,
