35 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - SYSTEM AND VARIOUS DIVISIONS. There is hereby  
 36 authorized, for the University of Arkansas - System and Various Divisions for

1 the 2024-2025 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or  
2 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
3 appropriated herein for such purposes: fifty (50) temporary or part-time  
4 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
5 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
6 for the appropriate classification.

7

8 SECTION 3. EXTRA HELP - DIVISION OF AGRICULTURE. There is hereby  
9 authorized, for the University of Arkansas - Division of Agriculture for the  
10 2024-2025 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
11 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
12 herein for such purposes: seven hundred (700) temporary or part-time  
13 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
14 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
15 for the appropriate classification.

16

17 SECTION 4. EXTRA HELP - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS, SCIENCES, AND  
18 THE ARTS. There is hereby authorized, for the University of Arkansas -  
19 Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts for the 2024-2025  
20 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary  
21 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
22 herein for such purposes: ten (10) temporary or part-time employees, when  
23 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
24 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
25 appropriate classification.

27 SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP - UA GRANTHAM. There is hereby authorized, for  
28 the University of Arkansas Grantham for the 2024-2025 fiscal year, the  
29 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as  
30 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two  
31 hundred fifty (250) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates  
32 of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
33 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
34 classification.

20 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CRIMINAL  
 22 JUSTICE INSTITUTE TRANSFER PROVISION. Immediately upon the effective date of  
 23 this Act the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, Treasurer of State and  
 24 Auditor of the State shall transfer on their books the sum of one hundred

32 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PINE TREE  
 34 RESEARCH STATION.

35 (a) The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas shall not sell  
 36 the property commonly known as the Pine Tree Research Station, located in St.

1 Francis County, Arkansas, which was acquired by the Board of Trustees of the  
2 University of Arkansas from the United States of America acting through the  
3 Forest Service in 1978, to a private entity or individual.

4 (b) The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas may sell the  
5 property commonly known as the Pine Tree Research Station, located in St.  
6 Francis County, Arkansas, which was acquired by the Board of Trustees of the  
7 University of Arkansas from the United States of America acting through the  
8 Forest Service in 1978, to:

9 (1) A non-profit corporation organized with the primary mission  
10 to keep the land open to the public and available for public use; and

11 (2) Organized and operated for a minimum of five (5) years.

12 (c) The property commonly known as the Pine Tree Research Station,  
13 located in St. Francis County, Arkansas, which was acquired by the Board of  
14 Trustees of the University of Arkansas from the United States of America  
15 acting through the Forest Service in 1978, shall remain open to the public  
16 for public use, including without limitation:

17 (1) Public fishing;

18 (2) Public hunting;

19 (3) Biking;

20 (4) Bird watching; and

21 (5) Hiking.

22 (d) All property commonly known as the Pine Tree Research Station,  
23 located in St. Francis County, Arkansas, which was acquired by the Board of  
24 Trustees of the University of Arkansas from the United States of America  
25 acting through the Forest Service in 1978, in row crop cultivation in the  
26 year 2020 is exempt from subsection (c) of this section.

30 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
31 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
32 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
33 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditure Restriction  
36 Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where

1 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and  
2 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in  
3 disbursement of said funds.

5 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
6 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
7 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
8 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
9 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
10 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
11 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
12 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

13  
14 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
15 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
16 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
17 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the operation of  
18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
19 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
20 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irreparable harm  
21 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
22 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
23 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
24 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024.
