     the minimum compensation schedule as established by Act 74 of the 2nd

     Extraordinary Session of the 84th General Assembly, or its successor, for
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     public school teachers, counselors, and librarians and other education
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     professionals as listed in subsection (a) below, the Arkansas School for the
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     Deaf is authorized to adjust current or new employees to at least the minimum
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     level of compensation for public school employees.
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        For current or new employees in the positions listed in subsection (a)
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     below, the Arkansas School for the Deaf may implement salary adjustments to
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     maintain equity between their teacher salaries and those of Central Arkansas

Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that is supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required, be provided by a transfer from the Performance Fund to the proper fund or fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. 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SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
