17	FUND TRANSFER. To provide funding for the appropriations authorized herei	n,
18	the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration - Assessment	
19	Coordination Division of the State of Arkansas shall certify monthly to t	he
20	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount of funding needed each mont	h to

35	FUND TRANSFERS. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of	the

- 9 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 11 TRANSFER PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer
- 12 of the State, the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration -
- 13 Assessment Coordination Division is authorized to transfer appropriation from
- 14 the Operating Expenses line item in the State Operations Program to the
- 15 Assessor's School special line item to assure sufficient resources are
- 16 available to provide required training for assessment personnel.
- 17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2023}{1000}$
- 18 <u>2024</u> through June 30, 2024 <u>2025</u>.

- 20 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 22 ASSESSMENT OF VEHICLES. (a) For purposes of assessing the value of a used
- 23 vehicle:
- 24 (1) If a used vehicle was assessed in calendar year 2020 and is
- 25 assessed in calendar year 2022, the value of the used vehicle as assessed in
- 26 calendar year 2022 shall not be higher than its published assessed value in
- 27 calendar year 2020; and
- 28 (2) If under subdivision (a)(1), a used vehicle's 2022 assessed
- 29 value is decreased, then a county assessor is not required to notify the
- 30 taxpayer of the decrease in the assessed value.
- 31 (b) Subsection (a) of this section shall be in effect only from the 32 effective date of this section through December 31, 2023.

- 34 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
- 35 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
- 36 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
2	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
3	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
4	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
5	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
6	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
7	
8	SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
9	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
10	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
11	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
12	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
13	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
14	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
15	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
16	
17	SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
18	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
19	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
20	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the operation of
21	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
22	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
23	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irreparable harm
24	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
25	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
26	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
27	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024.
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
