NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 4 DHE - REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. Upon 5 determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher 6 education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary 7 8 for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or 9 chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have 10 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between 11 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution, 12 after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 13 Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used 14 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General 15 Assembly. Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that institutions of higher education may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to institutions of higher education authorizing broad powers under this section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
