22	summa	rized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arka	nsas Legislative	
23	Counc	il or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage	and adoption.

25		SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determine	d by the General	
26	Assem	bly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prob	ibits the	
27	appro	priation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; t	hat the	
28	effec	tiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the	operation of	
29	the a	gency for which the appropriations in this Act are provi	ded, and that in	
30	the e	vent of an extension of the legislative session, the del	ay in the	
31	effec	tive date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irr	eparable harm	
32	upon	the proper administration and provision of essential gov	<u>ernmental</u>	
33	progr	ams. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist	and this Act	
34	being	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public	peace, health	
35	and s	afety shall be in full force and effect from and after J	uly 1, 2024.
