 14 tankers for fighting wildfires requires additional Professional Fees and  
 15 Services, and upon the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,  
 16 excess appropriation in Regular Salaries or Personal Services Matching may be  
 17 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in the Operations and Forestry  
 18 - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal appropriation sections.

19 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for  
 20 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is  
 21 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees  
 22 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the  
 23 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation  
 24 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in the  
 25 Operations and Forestry - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal  
 26 appropriation sections.

27 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2023~~  
 28 2024 through June 30, ~~2024~~ 2025.

30 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

32 REFUND TO EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to  
 33 charge fees to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission  
 34 for expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees  
 35 shall be deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a  
 36 refund to expenditure.

4 SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
6 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish  
7 upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional  
8 Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items.  
9 When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its  
10 operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be  
11 forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer  
12 of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas  
13 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum  
14 number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general  
15 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the  
16 General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums  
17 in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue  
18 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the  
19 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that  
20 the Arkansas Agriculture Department may operate more efficiently if some  
21 flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department authorizing  
22 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and  
23 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior  
24 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by  
25 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or  
26 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the  
27 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
28 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire  
29 section is void.

30 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2023~~  
31 2024 through June 30, ~~2024~~ 2025.

33 SECTION 45. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
34 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
35 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
36 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

1 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
2 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
3 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
4 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
5 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

6  
7 SECTION 46. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
8 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
9 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
10 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
11 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
12 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
13 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15  
16 SECTION 47. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
17 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
18 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the operation of  
20 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
21 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
22 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irreparable harm  
23 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
24 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
25 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
26 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024.
