23 transferred to Professional Fees and Services in the Operations and Forestry
24 - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal appropriation sections.

25 If the State Forestry Commission determines that the most effective way for
26 it to cooperate in the growing and distribution of forest planting stock is
27 by contracting work with private vendors and/or hiring temporary employees
28 for seasonal work, the Commission is hereby authorized, upon approval by the
29 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to transfer the necessary appropriation
30 authorized for Extra Help and Maintenance and General Operation in the
31 Operations and Forestry - Rural Community Fire Protection - Federal
32 appropriation sections.

33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2023~~
34 2024 through June 30, ~~2024~~ 2025.

36 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
2 REFUND TO EXPENDITURE. The Arkansas Forestry Commission is authorized to
3 charge fees to federal agencies and other states to reimburse the Commission
4 for expenditures made on behalf of these governmental units. These fees
5 shall be deposited into the State Forestry Fund in the State Treasury as a
6 refund to expenditure.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2023~~
8 2024 through June 30, ~~2024~~ 2025.

10 SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
12 PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish
13 upon request for the Arkansas Agriculture Department a special Promotional
14 Items appropriation to be used in the acquisition of promotional items.
15 When the Arkansas Agriculture Department wishes to transfer from its
16 operating expenses to the promotional items line, the request shall be
17 forwarded by the Arkansas Agriculture Department to the Chief Fiscal Officer
18 of the State for processing and for prior approval by the Arkansas
19 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Determining the maximum
20 number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general
21 revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the
22 General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums
23 in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue
24 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the
25 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that
26 the Arkansas Agriculture Department may operate more efficiently if some
27 flexibility is provided to the Arkansas Agriculture Department authorizing
28 broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and
29 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior
30 approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by
31 this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or
32 Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the
33 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
34 is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire
35 section is void.

36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2023~~

1 2024 through June 30, ~~2024~~ 2025.

3 SECTION 45. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
4 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
6 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

12
13 SECTION 46. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

21
22 SECTION 47. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
23 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
24 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2024 is essential to the operation of
26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
28 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2024 could work irreparable harm
29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2024.
