5	SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State				
6	Department for Social Security Administration Disability Determination for				
7	the 2025-2026 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or				
8	temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds				
9	appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty (20) temporary or part-time				
10	employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the				
11	Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act				
12	for the appropriate classification.

14	SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,				
15	to the State Department for Social Security Administration Disability				
16	Determination, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the				
17	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services and operating

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1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADDITIONAL 2 POSITIONS. The Director of the State Department for Social Security 3 Administration Disability Determination, after receiving the approval of the 4 Office of Personnel Management, and after seeking prior review by the 5 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, shall have the 6 authority to establish such new additional full time positions as may become 7 necessary to carry out the objectives of the department and/or to meet 8 Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs where such needs are 9 financed by Federal funds; provided that not more than two hundred fifty 10 (250) positions may be created in addition to those authorized in the Regular 11 Salaries section of this Act.

12 If the department requests continuation of any positions as established 13 herein, the positions must be requested as new positions in the department's 14 budget request.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 16 2024 2025 through June 30, 2025 2026.

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18 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 19 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 20 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 21 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 22 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 23 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 24 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 25 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 26 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 28 29 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 30 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 31 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 32 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 33 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 34 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 35 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 36

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1	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
3	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
4	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2025 is essential to the operation of
5	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
6	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
7	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2025 could work irreparable harm
8	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
9	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
10	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
11	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2025.
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
