6	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
7	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that public school districts and		
8	open-enrollment public charter schools will begin drafting employee contracts		
9	as early as March 2025 for 2025-2026 school year; and that this act is		
10	immediately necessary to ensure public school districts and open-enrollment		
11	public charter schools correctly draft and issue employee contracts in time		
12	for the 2025-2026 school year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist,		
13	and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
14	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
15	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
16	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
17	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
18	bill; or		
19	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
20	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
