2 (b) An <u>operator of an</u> excursion train operator <u>or an excursion boat</u> 3 may apply to the Director of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division for a 4 permit to sell and serve alcoholic beverages on an excursion train <u>or</u> 5 excursion boat operated in this state.

6 (c) An application under this section shall be in writing and verified 7 and shall detail information concerning the applicant for the permit and the 8 premises to be used by the applicant as the director shall require.

9 (d) If the director grants an application for a permit under this 10 section, he or she shall issue the permit in a form prescribed by rule.

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(e) A permit under this section shall:

12 (1) Contain a description of the excursion train <u>or excursion</u>
13 <u>boat</u> to be used by the <u>operator of an</u> excursion train operator <u>or excursion</u>
14 <u>boat</u>; and

15 (2) Permit the applicant to sell and serve alcoholic beverages
16 on the excursion train <u>or excursion boat</u> as authorized under this section.

17 (f) Upon receipt of a permit under this section, an <u>operator of an</u>
18 excursion train operator <u>or excursion boat</u> may:

19 (1) Sell and serve alcoholic beverages for on-premises
20 consumption during legal operating hours to a ticketed passenger of legal age
21 or to an individual of legal age attending a chartered event on the excursion
22 train or excursion boat;

(2) Store legally purchased alcoholic beverages on the excursion
 train <u>or excursion boat</u> to sell and serve to customers for on-premises
 consumption; and

26 (3) Store legally purchased alcoholic beverages at a separate27 facility as needed to meet the demand of customers.

(g) An <u>operator of an</u> excursion train operator <u>or excursion boat</u> shall
pay an annual permit fee of two hundred dollars (\$200) for an excursion train
<u>permit or an excursion boat</u> permit.

(h) An <u>A holder of an</u> excursion train permit holder or a holder of an excursion boat permit shall ensure that a copy of the excursion train permit or excursion boat permit issued under this section is posted in each excursion train or excursion boat operated by the <u>holder of the</u> excursion train permit holder or the excursion boat permit where alcoholic beverages are sold and served.

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(i) An <u>A holder of an</u> excursion train permit holder or holder of an
 <u>excursion boat permit</u> is authorized to sell and serve alcoholic beverages
 only when the excursion train <u>or excursion boat</u> is located in a territory
 that has authorized the sale of alcoholic beverages.

5 (j) The director shall adopt rules to implement and administer this 6 section.
