26	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY.	Legislative findings.	
27	The General Assembly finds t	hat:	
28	(1) A citizen of this	state may receive potable	water through a
29	lead service line;		
30	(2) Lead may detach f	rom a lead service line and	contaminate
31	water that moves through the lead	service line;	
32	(3) Lead exposure may	cause:	
33	<u>(A) Organ damag</u>	e, including without limita	tion brain
34	damage, kidney damage, heart damag	e, and lung damage;	
35	(B) Diminution	in bone mass and muscle gro	wth;
36	(C) Poor muscle	coordination;	



1	(D) High blood pressure;		
2	(E) Reproductive health complications;		
3	(F) Miscarriage;		
4	(G) Premature birth; and		
5	(H) Low birth weight;		
6	(4) Local water providers are required to replace lead service		
7	lines under 40 C.F.R. pts. 141 and 142, as they existed on October 30, 2024;		
8	and		
9	(5) Replacement of lead service lines and other facilities under		
10	40 C.F.R. pts. 141 and 142, as they existed on October 30, 2024, constitutes		
11	a public purpose to which water utility rate revenue and other public moneys,		
12	revenues, bond proceeds, and funds may be devoted.

14	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 14, Chapter 234, Subchapter 1, is		
15	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
16	<u>§ 14-234-123. Replacement of lead service lines — Issuance of bonds</u>		
17	Definitions.		
18	(a) As used in this section:		
19	(1) "Lead service line" means a water service line that is		
20	constructed of:		
21	(A) Lead, at least in part; or		
22	(B) Galvanized steel and exists or previously existed		
23	downstream of a service line or other conduit constructed of lead material or		
24	unknown material;		
25	(2) "Person" means:		
26	(A) A public or private corporation;		
27	(B) An individual;		
28	(C) A partnership;		
29	(D) An association; or		
30	(E) Other entity;		
31	(3) "Public entity" means:		
32	(A) A municipality;		
33	(B) A consolidated waterworks system as defined in § 25-		
34	<u>20-307;</u>		
35	(C) A water authority as defined in § 4-35-103;		
36	(D) A public facilities board as defined in § 14-137-103;		

1	(E) A water district as defined in § 14-116-103;		
2	(F) An improvement district as defined in § 14-89-801; or		
3	(G) Other political subdivision of the state; and		
4	(4) "Water provider" means a public entity that owns a		
5	waterworks system.		
6	(b) A water provider may replace a lead service line located on		
7	private property if the water provider:		
8	(1) Obtains the consent of the owner of the private property		
9	where the lead service line is located; and		
10	(2) Complies with local regulations and policies that govern the		
11	water provider.		
12	<u>(c) A water provider may:</u>		
13	(1) Spend water utility rate revenue and other public moneys,		
14	revenues, and funds on the replacement of a lead service line of a customer		
15	that the water provider serves; and		
16	(2) Use existing statutory authority that permits the water		
17	provider to issue bonds for waterworks system improvements to:		
18	(A) Issue bonds; and		
19	(B) Use the proceeds to replace a lead service line of a		
20	customer that the water provider serves.		
21	(d) A water provider replacing a lead service line that another person		
22	owns does not confer ownership or maintenance responsibilities for the		
23	replaced lead service line on the water provider unless the water provider		
24	and other person otherwise agree.
