3	(3) The emergency medication kit shall be:		
4	(A) Stored in a locked container or cabinet; and		
5	(B) Accessible only to authorized medical personnel.		
6	(4) The medication in the emergency medication kit shall only be		
7	administered by authorized medical personnel acting on the order of a		
8	physician in compliance with 21 C.F.R. § 1306.11 and 21 C.F.R. § 1306.21.		
9	(5) All drugs administered from the kit shall be replaced within		
10	seventy-two (72) hours by the designated licensed pharmacy based on a		
11	prescription for the patient to whom the drugs were administered.		
12	(c) The Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy shall adopt rules regarding		
13	the emergency medication kit, including without limitation:		
14	(1) The contents of the emergency medication kit;		
15	(2) The quantity of each medication in the emergency medication		
16	<pre>kit;</pre>		
17	(3) The storage and security requirements for an emergency		
18	medication kit; and		
19	(4) The use of an emergency medication kit.		
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
