24 25	(a) As used in this section, "emergency medication kit" means a kit		
26	containing medication that may be required for immediate therapeutic needs of a patient and that are not available from any other source in sufficient time		
27	to prevent risk of harm by delay.		
28	(b)(1) An alcohol and drug abuse treatment program, including a stand-		
29	alone detoxification facility or substance abuse treatment center, may		
30	maintain an emergency medication kit if the alcohol and drug abuse treatment		
31	program has a physician or other medical personnel on staff and is able to		
32	administer the controlled substances and noncontrolled legend drugs.		
33	(2)(A) The alcohol and drug abuse treatment program shall		
34		designate one (1) licensed pharmacy to supply and oversee the emergency	
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36	(B) The licer	nsed pharmacy under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of	

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1	this section shall be registered with the United States Drug Enforcement

12	seventy-two (72) hours by the designated licensed pharmacy based on a	
13	prescription for the patient to whom the drugs were administered.	
14	(c) The Arkansas State Board of Pharmacy shall adopt rules regarding	
15	the emergency medication kit, including without limitation:	
16	(1) The contents of the emergency medication kit, which shall	
17	not contain a Schedule II controlled substance;	
18	(2) The quantity of each medication in the emergency medication	
19	<pre>kit;</pre>	
20	(3) The storage and security requirements for an emergency	
21	medication kit; and	
22	(4) The use and access of an emergency medication kit.
