28	(a)(l) A person who is placed	on supervised probation	or <u>suspended</u>

(2) A warrantless search that is based on a waiver required by this section shall be conducted in a reasonable manner but does not need to be based on an articulable suspicion that the person is committing or has committed a criminal offense. (b)(1) A person who will be placed on supervised probation, suspended imposition of sentence, parole, or post-release supervision and is required to agree to the waiver required by this section shall acknowledge and sign the waiver. (2) If the person fails to acknowledge and sign the waiver required by this section, he or she is ineligible to be placed on supervised probation, <u>suspended imposition of sentence</u>, parole, or post-release supervision. (c) As used in this section, "residence" includes a garage or outbuilding on the property of a residence.
