11	the operator's actual knowledge that the occupant's leased space has been	
12	compromised.	
13	(c)(l) This section does not impose any responsibility on the operator	
14	for the care, custody, or control of the occupant's personal property.	
15	(2) The operator does not have a duty or obligation to determine	
16	whether a leased space has been compromised.	
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
