28	WHEREAS, the accredited Bicycle Assembly & Repair Technician program is
29 20	one (1) of only two (2) in the nation, and this distinction sets NorthWest
30	Arkansas Community College apart as a leader in the industry; and
31	INTEDENS, the secondited Disvels Assembly & Densin Technisisn pressure
32	WHEREAS, the accredited Bicycle Assembly & Repair Technician program
33 34	was developed in partnership with the Bicycle Industry Employers Association and provides students with one (1) year of specialized training that equates
34 35	to seven (7) years of hands-on shop experience; and

1 WHEREAS, supported by a three-year grant from the Walton Family 2 Charitable Support Foundation, Inc., NorthWest Arkansas Community College's state-of-the-art bicycle technician lab used in the accredited Bicycle 3 4 Assembly & Repair Technician program ensures students receive cutting-edge 5 training in repair and mechanics; and 6 7 WHEREAS, by raising the professionalism and skill level of bicycle 8 mechanics via the accredited Bicycle Assembly & Repair Technician program, 9 NorthWest Arkansas Community College is directly shaping the future of the 10 bicycle industry; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the Trail Technician program, the only one of its kind in the 13 world, sets a new benchmark for workforce training in trail planning, 14 building, and maintenance education; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the Trail Technician program offers a semester-long and a 17 year-long certification that prepares students for careers in community 18 development, trail construction, and sustainability; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the Trail Technician program provides training to students 21 nationwide, including fifty (50) United States Forest Service participants, 22 some of whom earned the Trail Management Certified Professional credential; 23 and 24 25 WHEREAS, the Trail Technician program has established industry-26 recognized standards for trail technology via its National Occupational 27 Competency Testing Institute Trail Technician Level 1 assessment; and 28 29 WHEREAS, no other institution in the world offers such a comprehensive, 30 industry-driven program in this field; and 31 32 WHEREAS, both the accredited Bicycle & Repair Technician program and 33 the Trail Technician program have earned national and international 34 credibility through collaboration, and the Trail Technician program in 35 particular has partnered with the Professional TrailBuilders Association, 36 American Trails, the DIRTT Project in Europe, the Forest Service, the
