26	WHEREAS, the Bulldogs were undefeated on the season with a record of
27	eight (8) wins and zero (0) losses; and

29	WHEREAS, the Bulldogs never trailed at any point in any game during the
30	season; and

32	WHEREAS, the Arkansas Activities Association sportsmanship rule was
33	invoked in every Bulldogs game of the season; and

35	WHEREAS, the Bulldogs averaged fifty-two and two-tenths (52.2) points
36	per game and averaged giving up only six and eight-tenths (6.8) points per
