20	WHEREAS, over thirty thousand (30,000) students were homeschooled in
21	Arkansas during the 2023-2024 school year; and

23	WHEREAS, homeschooling offers flexibility, efficiency, and
24	effectiveness in teaching students in Arkansas, and this benefit allows
25	homeschooling families to offer increased opportunities for community
26	involvement and service to others for their children; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, homeschooling is not a one-size-fits-all plan, and the
29	education can be customized to the student's learning styles and preferences
30	and can be beneficial to students with special needs; and

32	WHEREAS, homeschooling provides benefits in academics, mental health,
33	physical health, and social development; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, homeschooling encourages autonomy and independence and allows
36	children to harness their own unique qualities and interests; and

3	entrepreneurship and often to begin working on their own small businesses;

6	WHEREAS, homeschooling emphasizes family as a foundation for social
7	development and development of faith; and

9	WHEREAS, homeschooling is accommodating to special situations and works
10	well for military families, families who travel, and families contending with
11	illness and challenging work schedules; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, homeschooling parents are able to value an individual
14	student's potential and focus on this individual potential instead of minimum
15	standards and standardized testing, and these parents are allowed to shape
16	homeschooling so that learning for the students can be reactive to new
17	methods and new concepts regarding positive child development; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, homeschooling provides for a focus on life skills that
20	students can use as they progress into adulthood as homeschooling allows
21	students to dedicate time to learning anything from cooking to budgeting,
