19	NICK FOUNDATION ON THE THIRTIETH
20	ANNIVERSARY OF THE KIDNAPPING OF MORGAN

23	WHEREAS, on June 9, 1995, six-year-old Morgan Chauntel Nick was
24	kidnapped from a little league baseball game in Alma, Arkansas, and a massive
25	state and federal law enforcement investigation ensued and continues, as
26	Morgan Nick remains missing; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, June 9, 2025, will mark the thirtieth anniversary of the
29	kidnapping and disappearance of Morgan Nick; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, Morgan's mother, Colleen Nick, formed the Morgan Nick
32	Foundation in 1996 and serves as full-time Executive Director of the
33	foundation; and
34	
35	WHEREAS, the Morgan Nick Foundation believes that to reduce the number
36	of child abductions, children must be educated and empowered with the skills

1 necessary to protect themselves from the dangers of abduction, and the 2 foundation is proactive in offering prevention education programs for 3 children, communities, and schools; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Morgan Nick Foundation strives to be an organization 6 recognized by the public and law enforcement as a leading resource in 7 the prevention and recovery of missing and exploited children; and 8 9 WHEREAS, through Colleen Nick's outstanding leadership, the foundation 10 assists thousands of families in crisis and successfully provides intervention, support, and reunification to children and their families; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, for years, the Arkansas State Police has partnered with the 14 Morgan Nick Foundation, which has been instrumental in countless 15 investigations and has directly contributed to the safe recovery of missing 16 and exploited children and the combatting of human trafficking in Arkansas; 17 and 18 19 WHEREAS, beyond investigative assistance, the Morgan Nick Foundation 20 works with the Arkansas State Police in prevention and training efforts, 21 ensuring officers are equipped with the latest techniques and knowledge to 22 handle child abduction and exploitation cases, and the foundation's role in 23 community engagement and education further strengthens Arkansas's overall 24 approach to safeguarding children; and 25 26 WHEREAS, since the 2024 formation of the VALOR Group (which stands for 27 Victory through Advocacy, Law Enforcement, Outreach, and Recovery) composed 28 of members of the Arkansas Human Trafficking Council, the Morgan Nick 29 Foundation has provided the Arkansas State Police with critical investigative 30 assistance, training, and networking expertise that has directly contributed 31 to the success of Arkansas State Police operations; and 32 WHEREAS, in January 2025 alone, with the support of the Morgan Nick 33 34 Foundation, the Arkansas State Police successfully recovered sixteen (16) missing children in Arkansas, and in 2024, this partnership resulted in the 35

36 recovery of eighty-two (82) children; and

2 WHEREAS, Colleen Nick was instrumental in the adoption of the Morgan 3 Nick AMBER Alert in Arkansas, making Arkansas the third state in the nation 4 to have a statewide child abduction alert system in place; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Colleen Nick is a nationally recognized spokesperson and 7 advocate for missing children and has spoken at the FBI Academy on Marine 8 Corps Base Quantico in Virginia, the National Homicide Investigators 9 Association Training Conference, and at National Missing Children's Day with 10 former United States Attorney General Janet Reno; and 11 12 WHEREAS, Colleen Nick was invited to meet with former President George 13 W. Bush and former First Lady Laura Bush at the White House Conference on 14 Missing, Exploited, and Runaway Children in 2002 to explore new resources in 15 the ongoing fight to recover missing children and prevent child abductions; 16 and 17 18 WHEREAS, Colleen Nick serves as an independent consultant with the 19 National Center for Missing & Exploited Children and the Office of Juvenile 20 Justice and Delinquency Prevention, and she travels the nation training law 21 enforcement about the issue of missing and exploited children; and 22 23 WHEREAS, Colleen Nick is a co-creator of Team HOPE, a support program 24 for families of the missing, at the National Center for Missing & Exploited 25 Children; and 26 27 WHEREAS, Colleen Nick's passion and steadfast hope motivates her daily 28 to fight for America's missing children and she continues to work with 29 countless dedicated people to make a difference, one child at a time, 30 31 NOW THEREFORE, 32 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL 33 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS: 34 35 THAT the House of Representatives recognize Colleen Nick and the Morgan 36 Nick Foundation on the thirtieth anniversary of the kidnapping of Morgan Nick
